

“American Bonds: How Credit Markets Shaped a Nation”

The issue of moving credit around the United States, both across territory and across social groups, has been an important part of U.S. politics since the founding of the nation. The talk will explain how this idea justified a transformation in economic and social policy that profoundly shapes the American experience to this day.
