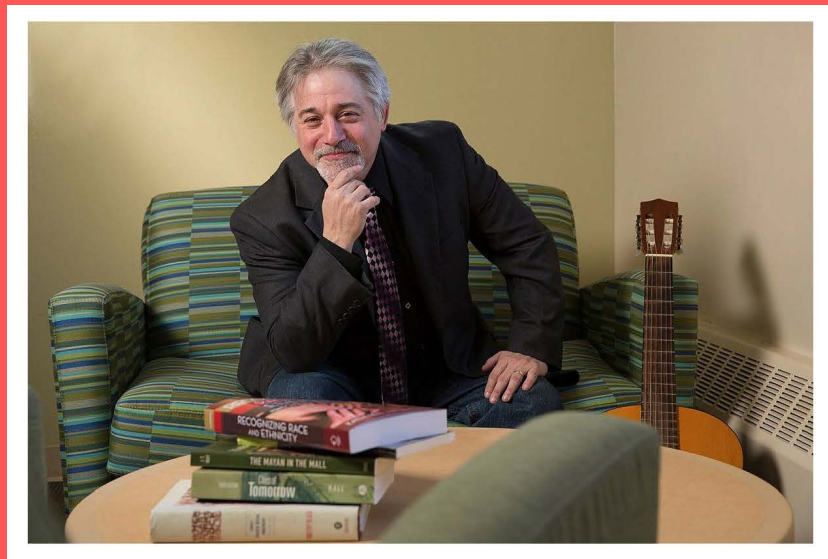


SINGING LECTURE WITH PROF. COREY DOLGON
