Business Meals Documentation For Sponsored Projects

While there is no one definition, the consensus at the federal level appears to be that business meals are "working" meals where food and beverages are brought in to the meeting room while discussions continue. This interpretation has been indicated emphatically in discussions with the policy offices of both the Department of Health & Human Services (DHHS) and the National Science Foundation (NSF). The issue is whether or not it is necessary to "break" for lunch. When this happens, as in the case where a meeting is interrupted to physically travel to a restaurant, the meal is no longer considered by these agencies to be business in nature. Please note that alcoholic beverage cannot be charged to your sponsored project.
