## Sociology 3191: Internship Program in Sociology \& Criminology

## Overview

An Internship is a career-related, educational, work experience where students take on roles as workers in an organization. Internships provide students with the opportunity to gain hands-on experience, the chance to "test" various careers and work environments, the opportunity to identify and develop career-related skills and abilities, and also provide a chance to connect with professionals for future networking.

## Academic Guidelines

Sociology 3191 is the on-line course, which accompanies the internship experience. It provides students the opportunity to earn academic credit for their internship experiences. Students can earn between 1-3 credits each semester.

Interns are required to work a minimum of fifty (50) hours for each one (1) credit hour. For the required $\mathbf{3}$ credit hours, you will need to work a total of $\mathbf{1 5 0}$ hours (either in 1 semester, or split between 2 ).

## YOU MUST BE ENROLLED IN SOC 3191 TO RECEIVE CREDIT!

SOC 3191 is repeatable to a maximum of 9 hours, up to 6 credits in one semester. A maximum of 3 credits counts toward the SOC/CRIM major and it is graded S/U
